By the time many of you read this we will be through with the Texas River Marathon (prelim) which will be the fifth race of the season. April 2nd and 3rd were very busy for some of our racers who paddled in the Greens Bayou Race(s) on Saturday and then Turned around and paddled in the East Fork-West Fork Race on Sunday morning. The Greens Bayou race had its usual strong turnout and the EFWF has made a strong comeback with 25 boats entered.

Two new races were added to our schedule this year. The Hidalgo Falls River Festival Race, which is a completely new race, had 31 boats entered. A special thanks to TCRA Board member Charlie Lewis for taking the lead on this race. By all accounts this was a great event. At least all accounts that didn't talk about the headwinds said it was a great event! The Zedler Mill Classic combined the TCRA Unlimited State Championship Race, TCRA Unlimited Solo Race, a Pro Aluminum Race, and The Tri county Challenge, Novice, Luling Business class, and recreational solo for a total of 65 boats entered! This event is a tribute to what can happen when a town such as Luling takes notice of who is coming to town and then provides a venue. I am extremely pleased with the cooperation Between the Luling Economic Development Council, TWS Board, TCRA, and Luling Parks and Recreation with input from Texas parks and Wildlife and the GBRA. The fish fry, band, and general carnival atmosphere made this a great time. TCRA member Kevin Bradley did a yeomans job keeping everyone on their toes to get ready for this event, Randy Engelke of Luling Parks and Rec and his crew did an amazing job of getting the Zedler Mill property and the Luling 90 put in ready for this event, and Trey Bailey of Luling Economic Development Corporation took care of funding matters. Kristin Daniel, Linda Cochran took care of the race day registrations (much to the chagrin of those who didn't read the part about paying a late fee for rae day registration).

On th subject of race day registrations and late fees...WAKE UP. If you could have seen through the curtain of rain at the start of the prelim last year you would have seen Linda and Lillie Cochran, Diane Petrisky, and Kristin Daniel looking like drowned rats trying to make heads or tails of the soggy forms. The time is in the past when we can wait until the morning of these large races to enter and not charge a late fee. We no longer even allow race day registration at the Martindale triathlon. 2005 East Fork – West Fork Canoe Challenge
Texas' Only Night Start Canoe Race
16 Miles on the San Jacinto Rivers

The 2005 East Fork – West Fork Canoe Challenge was held on April 3, 2005. The course starts on Peach Creek at Lake Houston State Park in New Caney Texas, runs into and down the East Fork of the San Jacinto River, and finishes up the West Fork of the San Jacinto River at Blairs Landing in Humble Texas. The start time was pushed back to 5:00 AM due to the change to daylight savings time earlier that morning (only one racer forgot to set his clock forward, but he was able to hop in shortly after the start and have a respectable finish).

This was a very nice turnout for the race this year (6th year) with 25 boats and 39 racers participating. It was a beautiful late night start with a crescent moon and beautiful stars overhead. Peach Creek at the start was running quite shallow with lots of mid-channel bars to negotiate. To add to the adventure, there was a quite dense fog lifting off of the creek resulting in very challenging visibility. Once out of the creek however, the course was flat and fast with little current in the rivers and no wind. As a result this was one of the fastest races ever on this course.

Richard Steppe and Philippe Blouin finished first overall, paddling the “Steppe Missile” Tandem Unlimited boat home in 2:27:00. This is only 4 seconds off of the course record of 2:26:56 set in 2002 by Julie Morgan and Colin Grimshaw. **Holly Nelson, Mary Tipton and Sandy Yonley** pushed across the finish in a close second in 2:31:34 running in a C3 (Unlimited class). **Dave Bartell** finished third overall with a very impressive 2:32:00 which is a new Mens Solo Unlimited record. Also of note was the new Aluminum record of 3:06:43 set by **Mike Stinson and Scott Cummings**.

It seems that everybody really enjoyed the race this year. Hopefully we can build on this momentum and grow this race into a standard of the Texas racing season.

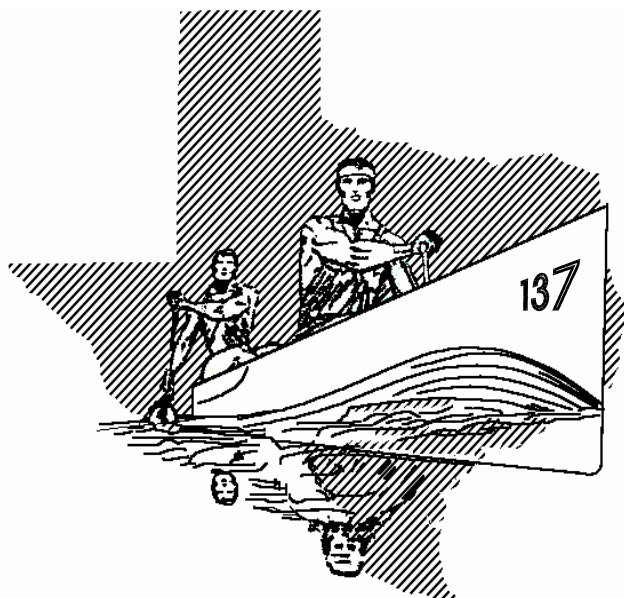
